Do you want to build your career within the cardiorespiratory nursing speciality?

Royal Brompton & Harefield NHS Foundation Trust are offering this 2 year part-time course to external candidates for a total cost of £5000.

The MSc in Cardiorespiratory nursing is designed to provide up to date knowledge and identify evidence upon which to base both current and future practice. It will allow you to develop skills in clinical practice, research and leadership.

The course is made up of compulsory and optional modules such as:

- Applied Healthcare Research
- Evidence based Healthcare
- Heart Failure
- Respiratory Nursing
- Advanced Life Support.
- Physical Assessment

You will be taught by experts in the fields of cardiorespiratory nursing and medicine and will be assessed using a variety of methods such as poster presentation, assignments, practical assessments and exams.

We aim to run this course in partnership with Buckinghamshire New University in October 2018 (subject to validation in July'18). It is a 2 year part-time course and as an entry requirement you must have at least two years' recent experience working within the cardiorespiratory field.
